Built over Roman ruins in the heart of the City, the colossal Bloomberg Place by Foster & Partners will provide over a hectare of office for global media giant Bloomberg.

The building comprises two blocks with triangular plans that will be connected at ground level by an arcade and at a mid-point by an elevated bridge providing 61,594 sq m of office space.

A museum in a double-height basement below, the building protects a Roman temple discovered during excavation of the site. Writing tablets and leather goods are among the 14,000 artefacts unearthed from the archaeological site, some dating to 43AD.

Diffusion supplied over 900 various fan coil units through-out the building including our eco Highline 270 EC-DC fan coil unit with low specific fan powers of 0.17 w/l/s.
